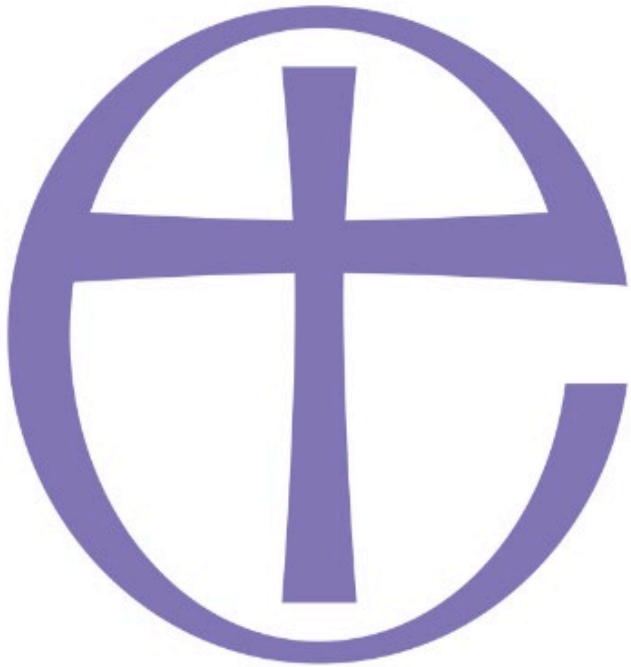


SAFEGUARDING
